1. *Agathis* Salisbury

Sulawesi, Moluccas, Philippines.

PALAWAN, SAMAR, possibly other parts of S Philippines. Forest emergent and locally common, up to 1200m altitude.

BABUYAN ISLS, N LUZON to MINDANAO. Occurs mostly in montane forests to 2200m.
