LUZON: Rizal. Medium altitude forests.

Buxus pachyphylla Merr., PJS 9 c (1914) Bot. 310; EPFP 2 (1923) 464. –Type: BS 20828 Escritor
(US*, iso). Luzon: Quezon prov., Mt Cadig, near Guinayangan, 9 Mar 1913.

LUZON: Quezon. Primary forests at low and medium altitudes.

Buxus rivularis Merr., PJS 9 c (1914) Bot. 309; EPFP 2 (1923) 465. –Type: BS 13169 Foxworthy &
Ramos (US*, iso). Luzon: Quezon prov., Guinatacutan (=Kinatacutan), on rocks along the river,
altitude 75-100m, Mar 1911.

LUZON: Quezon. On boulders along periodically flash-flooding streams, low altitudes.

LUZON: Pampanga, Bataan, Rizal, Quezon, PALAWAN, SIBUYAN, MINDANAO:
Surigao. Low and medium altitude primary forests.

Afghanistan, India, Sri Lanka, China, Taiwan, Sumatra, Java, Bali, Philippines.

LUZON: Mountain Province (Mt Data). Mossy forests, altitude c. 2000m.
