LUZON: Camarines, Albay, PALAWAN, MASBATE, MINDANAO. Lowland and medium altitude forests.

MINDANAO. Forests, sea-level to 500m altitude.

### 3. Licania Aublet

PALAWAN. Forest on ultramafics, 0-300m altitudes, including seashore forests.

BUSUANGA, PALAWAN, PANAY, SAMAR, MINDANAO: Surigao. Lowland forests, 0-400 (800)m.

Sunda Isls, Moluccas, New Guinea, New Britain, Admiralty Isls, Solomon Isls, Caroline Isls, Australia (Queensland, Northern Territory).  
N LUZON to PALAWAN and MINDANAO. Lowland and medium altitude forests.

## 5. **Parinari** Aublet ['Parinarium']

Sumatra, Borneo, Philippines, Sulawesi.  
PALAWAN.

CULION, SAMAR, MINDANAO: Davao, Surigao. Lowland forests, hillsides, ridges, altitude up to 300m.

Burma, Peninsular Malaysia, Borneo (Sarawak; Sabah; Kalimantan), Philippines.

MINDANAO: Surigao, BUCAS GRANDE. Lowland forests and open slopes.

**NOTE:** check relationship of this subsp with the typical subsp. From the type images at hand, I think there's no P costata ssp costata in the Philippines.

### **Known only in cultivated state:**

**Chrysobalanus icaco** L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 513; --Prance, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 10 (1989) 643, Fig. 1.

Indigenous to the neotropics, mainly in coastal areas; W & C Africa, naturalized in Fiji, cultivated in Vietnam; cultivated in Singapore where it has escaped and naturalized.

Occasionally cultivated in the Philippines.
