Iphigenia Kunth

Iphigenia indica (L.) A Kunth, Enum. 4 (1843) 213; --Merr., EPFP 1 (1922) 202; --Jessop, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 9 (1979) 198, Fig. 4.

Sri Lanka, India to Thailand, S China, N Sumatra (Lake Toba), Java, Madura Is, Lesser Sunda Isls (Timor; Wetar), Philippines, New Guinea, Australia (Northern Territory; Queensland; West Australia).

LUZON: Rizal, Cavite, Laguna, MINDANAO: Bukidnon, Davao. Low and medium altitude grasslands. Rare or local.

Cultivated:

Gloriosa superba L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 305; --Jessop, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 9 (1979) 193, Fig. 1, 2.

Tropical and S Africa, Madagascar, India to Indochina, Java (also Madura and Kangean Isls), Lesser Sunda Isls, S Sulawesi. In the Philippines in cultivation only as an ornamental plant.
