### 1. *Calogyne* R Brown

S China, Philippines, Moluccas (Tenimber Is), New Guinea, N Australia. LUZON: Zambales, Bulacan, Rizal, CULION.

### 2. *Scaevola* Linnaeus

Lanyu, Borneo (Mt Kinabalu, Mt Meliau, Mt Tavau), Philippines, Talud Is. LUZON, PALAWAN, SIBUYAN, MINDANAO.

**2. *Scaevola oppositifolia*** R Br., Prodr. (1810) 583; --Leenh., Fl. Males. ser. 1, 5 (1957) 342, Fig. 5a-f.

Philippines, Sulawesi, Moluccas (Morotai; Ternate; Sula Is; Seram; Ambon), New Guinea, New Ireland, Australia (N Queensland). Mostly in rather open sites such as along forest edges, road and river sides, in shrubberies and secondary vegetation, rarely in forest. Fl. & fr. Jan.-Dec.

**3. *Scaevola taccada*** (Gaertn.) Roxb., Hort. Beng. (1814) 15;

Madagascar, E Africa (Kenya), SE Asia, throughout Malesia, tropical Australia, Micronesia, Melanesia, and Hawaii. Restricted to the seashore, usually on the open sandy beach or on coastal cliffs of rocky coasts. Fl. & fr. Jan.-Dec.
