1. *Gunnera* Linnaeus

Sumatra, W & C Java, Borneo (Mt Kinabalu), Philippines, NE Sulawesi (Mt Klabat), Sangihe Is, New Guinea (incl. Goodenough Is & New Britain), Solomon Isls (Kolombangara).

LUZON: Pangasinan, Ifugao, Mountain Province, Benguet, Nueva Vizcaya, Laguna, Quezon, Albay, NEGROS: Negros Oriental (Cuernos Mtns). Along streams, seepage slopes and damp ridges, mostly on open or semi-shaded sites in disturbed habitats, colonizing bare lands, often gregarious, altitude 1000-2400m.
