

Family 117B. HYDRANGEACEAE

Commonly in the montane zone between 1200-2400m, in thickets, exposed ridges, ravines and clearings in the mossy forests.

Extra-Philippine distribution

BATAN, LUZON: Ifugao, Mountain Province, Benguet, Rizal, Laguna, NEGROS, LEYTE, MINDANAO: Davao. Usually in the mossy forest, altitude 900-2200m. Thickets or open forests.
