### 1. *Glinus* Linnaeus

S Europe, N and tropical Africa, S to SE Asia, Sri Lanka, Malesia to Australia and America. In Malesia: Sumatra, Java, Lesser Sunda Isls (Bali, Sumba, Timor), Sulawesi (also Salayer Is), Philippines.

**2. *Glinus oppositifolius* (L.) A DC**, Bull. Herb. Boiss. 2, 1 (1901) 552; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 270, Fig. 1; --*Mollugo oppositifolia* L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 89; --Merr., Fl. Manila (1912) 199; EPFP 2 (1923) 135.

Tropical Africa and Asia, throughout Malesia to N Australia.

### 2. *Mollugo* Linnaeus

**1. *Mollugo pentaphylla* L.**, Sp. Pl. (1753) 89; --Merr., EPFP 2 (1923) 135; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 268.

Old World tropics and subtropics, apparently very rare in Australia; throughout Malesia, also in New Britain, Micronesia, New Caledonia.
