Nymphaea nouchali Burm.*f.*, Fl. Ind. (1768) 120; --Merr., PJS 19 (1921) 350; EPFP 2 (1923) 140. Tropical Asia to Malaya. In the Philippines: N LUZON to MINDANAO. In shallow lakes, locally very abundant.

Nymphaea stellata Willd., Sp. Pl. 2 (1799) 1153; --Fern.-Villar, Novis. App. (1880) 9; --Vidal, Phan. Cuming. Philip. (1885) 93; Rev. Pl. Vasc. Filip. (1886) 46; --Merr., EPFP 2 (1923) 140. *Castalia stellata* (Willd.) Blume, Bijdr. (1825) 49; --Merr., Fl. Manila (1912) 201. Tropical Asia, Africa and Malaya. In the Philippines: LUZON (Laguna de Bay). In shallow water along lake margin. Much less common than the preceding species.
