Nepal, India and Sri Lanka to S China, Sumatra (E coast, Palembang), Peninsular Malaysia, Borneo (NW Kalimantan, Sarawak, Sabah), Philippines. MINDORO, CEBU, SIBUTU, BASILAN. Thickets, especially near the seashore.

Andaman Isls and SE Asia to Taiwan, throughout Malesia to NW New Guinea.

BATANES to MINDANAO and PALAWAN, in the more seasonal parts of the archipelago, mostly in thickets and dry second-growth forests, at low and medium altitudes. Flowering December to April, fruiting January-May.

Tropical Africa, India and Sri Lanka through Myanmar, Thailand, Indochina, across Malesia to the Solomon Isls and N Australia. LUZON: Mountain Province, Pangasinan, Bataan, Rizal, Camarines, POLILLO, CULION, PALAWAN. Dry thickets and open forests at low and medium altitudes, often near the sea. Flowering and fruiting throughout the year.
