

Family 85. PORTULACACEAE

1. *Portulaca* Linnaeus

Portulaca oleracea L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 445; --Merr., Fl. Manila (1912) 200; EPFP 2 (1923) 136.

Pantropic.

Throughout the Philippines in the settled areas. Purslane.

Portulaca pilosa L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 445; --Merr., Fl. Manila (1912) 199; EPFP 2 (1923) 136; --Geesink, Blumea 17 (1969) 295.

ssp. pilosa

Portulaca pachyrhiza [non Gagnep., Bull. Soc. Bot. Fr. 56 (1909) 41] ;-- Merr., EPFP 2 (1923) 136 (race *tuberosa*).

Native of tropical America.

LUZON: Ilocos Norte, La Union, Pangasinan, Rizal, Cavite. Dry open places and along sandy seashores.

ssp. grandiflora (Hook.) Geesink, Blumea 17 (1969) 297;

Portulaca grandiflora Hook.

Native of tropical America, cultivated as an ornamental and occasionally escaped elsewhere.

Portulaca quadrifida L., Mant. 1 (1767) 73; Fl. Manila (1912) 200; EPFP 2 (1923) 137.

Tropical Asia and Africa to Malaya, Marianas, and Carolines. Probably an introduced plant in the Philippines.

BATAN, LUZON: Cagayan to Rizal. Weed in human settlements.

2. *Talinum* Jussieu

Talinum triangulare (Jacq.) Willd.
