2. *Turpinia* Ventenat

1. *Turpinia borneensis* (Merr. & Perry) Linden, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 6 (1960) 56, Fig. 1a-f. Borneo, Philippines.

2. *Turpinia ovalifolia* Elmer, LPB 2 (1908) 490, --Linden, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 6 (1960) 58, Fig. 1o. *Turpinia lucida* Nakai, J. Arn. Arb. 5 (1924) 80; --Merr., EPFP 4 (1925) 244. *Turpinia pachyphylla* PJS 27 (1925) 33; EPFP 4 (1925) 252. --Type: Loher 14463. Luzon: Rizal prov., Peninsular Malaysia, Philippines. LUZON, PALAWAN. Low and medium altitude primary forests, on some mountains exceeding 2200m.

3. *Turpinia pomifera* (Roxb.) DC, Prodr. 2 (1825) 3; --Linden, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 6 (1960) 58, Fig. 1j-k. Continental Asia from E of the Himalayas eastward to Sumatra, Java, Philippines, Sulawesi. Throughout the Philippines, 0-2100m.

4. *Turpinia simplicifolia* Merr., PJS 27 (1925) 34; EPFP 4 (1925) 252; --Linden, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 6 (1960) 55. --Type: Hainan, Philippines. LUZON: Rizal (Montalban and Balacbac). Low altitude forests.

5. *Turpinia sphaerocarpa* Hassk., Flora 25, ii (1842) Beibl. 1, p. 42; --Linden, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 6 (1960) 57, Fig. 1l-n. *Turpinia sambucifolia* Elmer, LPB 9 (1934) 3217. --Type: Sumatra, Peninsular Malaysia, Java, Philippines, Sulawesi, Lesser Sunda Isls, Moluccas. Rainforests on various soils, 50-2000m.
