New Guinea, Moluccas (Morotai, Halmahera), Sulawesi, Borneo (Sarawak), Philippines. LUZON: Cagayan, Aurora, Rizal, Quezon, Laguna, Camarines, Albay, Sorsogon, LEYTE, SAMAR, CAMIGUIN. In primary and secondary forests, on ridges, slopes and along riverbanks, from low altitudes to 1200 m.

Bangladesh, Assam, Andamans, Burma (Arakan, Yangon, Pegu, Tenasserim), Sumatra, Peninsular Malaysia, Langkawi I., Java, Lesser Sunda Isls (Bali; Sumbawa; Flores), Borneo (Sabah, W Kutai) and the Philippines.

LUZON: Cagayan, Abra,

Mountain Province, Benguet, La Union, Pangasinan, Zambales, Bulacan, Camarines, Sorsogon, PALAWAN, NEGROS. In primary and secondary forests on hills and mountains up to 1700 m. Reported from riverbanks, ridges, ravines and forest borders.
