1. *Juncus* Linnaeus

1. *Juncus bufonius* L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 328; --Merr., EPFP 1 (1922) 201; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 212.

Circumboreal, in the tropics confined to the montane regions. In Malesia: Borneo (Sabah, Mt Kinabalu) and Philippines. LUZON. Along bridle trails in the mossy forest, altitude 1900m.

2. *Juncus effusus* L., Sp. Pl. (1753) 326; --Merr., EPFP 1 (1922) 201; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 211, Fig. 1, 2b.

Throughout the temperate zones (especially in N hemisphere), in the tropics confined to montane zone, not in Australia. In Malesia: Sumatra (Aceh), Peninsular Malaysia (Cameron Highlands), Java, Borneo (Sabah), Philippines, New Guinea. LUZON, MINDANAO. Wet places, pools, lake borders, altitude 1400-3000m, locally abundant.

3. *Juncus prismatocarpus* R Br., Prodr. (1810) 259; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 213, Fig. 2a.

Sri Lanka, SE to E Asia, N Sumatra, Peninsular Malaysia (Cameron Highlands), W-C Java, Philippines, New Guinea, Australia, Tasmania, New Zealand. LUZON, MINDANAO.

2. *Luzula* de Candolle

var. *australasica* (Steud.) Buchenau, Oesterr. Bot. Z. (1898) 216; --Backer, Fl. Males. ser. 1, 4 (1951) 215.

Extremely polymorphous, throughout the temperate zones, in the tropics confined to montane sites. In Malesia: Philippines and New Guinea. LUZON.

E Himalayas to China, Philippines, Borneo (Sabah, Mt Kinabalu), S Sulawesi, New Guinea.
