1. *Typha* Linnaeus

Notes: Briggs and Johnson [Contr. NSW Nat. Herb. 4 (1968) 57-69] maintains that what is known as this species in Malesia and Australia are actually made up of 2 entities: *T. dominguensis* Pers. and *T. orientalis* C Presl
